



SMOOTH ALDER
(*Alnus Serrulata*)
A/S 1 yr., 6''- 12''
G Moderately shade tolerant; low drought tolerance.
C Thicket-forming shrub/small tree with dark green foliage. Suitable for streambank stabilization. Grows best in wet bottomlands and stream riparian areas.



PINE/CONIFER VARIETY
(*Pinus Spp.*)
A/S 3 yrs., 5''- 10''
G Best in full sun, young trees tolerate light shade. Prefers moist, well-drained soils
C Soft needles, 50'-80' tall and 30'-50' wide. Conical form when young, open form with age. Fast growing.

RIVER BIRCH
(*Betula Nigra*)
A/S 1 yr., 12''- 18''
G Tolerates heavy, poorly drained areas but widely adapted to varying soils. Full sun.
C Reddish brown exfoliating bark provides ornamental value. Often grows along streams. 50'-70'.



EASTERN REDBUD
(*Cercis Canadensis*)
A/S 1 yr., 12''- 18''
G Full sun to light shade. Prefers moist, well drained soils. Avoid permanently wet soils.
C Shape is rounded to broad and flat-topped. 20'-30' tall & 25'-35' wide. Lavender buds in early spring.



SERVICEBERRY
(*Amelanchier Laevis* or *A. Canadensis*)
A/S 1 yr., 12''- 18''
G Plant in moist well-drained soil. Prefers partial sun and shade mix.
C Small understory tree with white flowers in early spring, orange-red fall color and gray bark. Produces edible purple-black fruit in late summer for birds.



EASTERN SYCAMORE
(*Platanus Occidentalis*)
A/S 1 yr., 12''- 18''
G Full sun preferred. Moist, deep, rich, well-drained soils. Tolerates moderate salt & drought conditions.
C Massive white branches, mosaic of colored bark. 75'-90' tall & 60'-70' wide.



SUGAR MAPLE
(*Acer Saccharum*)
A/S 1 yr., 12''- 24''
G Full sun to part shade. Deep, well-drained acidic to slightly alkaline soil. Moist soil preferred but has moderate drought tolerance.
C Dense, rounded crown. 60'-75' tall & 40'-50' wide.

2020 TREE DESCRIPTIONS

CONCOLOR FIR
(Abies Concolor)

A/S

G Best in full sun and moist, well-drained, sandy soil. Established trees tolerate some soil dryness.

C 40-70' tall, spread 20-30'. Narrow conical shape with blue-green needles.



DOUGLAS FIR
(Pseudotsuga Menziesii)

A/S

G Best in full sun, with moist, neutral to acidic soil.

C Broadly conical form with open, tiered, slightly pendulous branches. Grows 40-80' tall, 15-20' wide. Excellent specimen or used for screening.



FRASER FIR
(Abies Fraseri)

A/S

G Prefers full sun.

C Profuse spring bloom, late summer fruit. Flowers attract butterflies; fruits are eaten by songbirds, turkeys, deer and small mam



RED OAK
(Quercus Rubra)

A/S

G Best in full sun, grows in acidic, loamy, moist, sandy, well-drained and clay soils, some drought tolerance.

C Moderately fast growing, easily transplanted. Grows 70-80' tall with a broad, rounded shape.

(Acer)

WINTERBERRY
(Ilex Verticillata)

A/S

G Suited to wet soils; needs some sun.

C Slow-growing shrub with upright habit. Grows 6-10' tall and will form large clumps. Bright red, glossy fruit on female plants.



SWAMP WHITE OAK
(Quercis Bicolor)

A/S

G Full sun. Grows in well-drained and wet soils. Tolerates compacted soil and some salt exposure.

C Produces fall color, yellow, bronze and red-purple. 50-60' tall with 50-60' spread at maturity.
